COVID-19 and Seasonal Allergies

Common Symptoms of COVID-19

- ✓ Fever and chills
- ✓ Muscle and body aches
- ✓ New loss of taste or smell
- ✓ Nausea or vomiting
- ✓ Diarrhea

Common

Symptoms of Both

- ✓ Cough
- ✓ Fatigue
- ✓ Headache
- ✓ Sore throat
- ✓ Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing*
- ✓ Congestion or runny nose

Common Symptoms of Allergies

- ✓ Itchy or watery eyes
- ✓ Sneezing

*Seasonal allergies do not usually cause shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, unless a person has a respiratory condition such as asthma that can be triggered by exposure to pollen.
