BOROUGH OF NORTH CALDWELL, ESSEX COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING §3-94.A OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTH CALDWELL REGARDING RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of North Caldwell seeks to reflect the residency requirements of the State of New Jersey as stated in P.L. 2022, Chapter 111 by which a Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator, if not a resident of the municipality, shall reside within a reasonable proximity of the municipality to ensure a prompt response; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By the Mayor and Council of the Borough of North Caldwell, County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. §3-94 (A) Appointment, term, qualifications. There shall be appointed an Emergency Management Coordinator. The Emergency Management Coordinator shall serve for a term of three years and shall be a resident of the borough shall reside within a reasonable proximity of the municipality, if said appointee is not a resident of the municipality, to ensure a prompt response or coordination of municipal resources for any local incident. As a condition of his appointment and his right to continue for the full term of his appointment, each Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator shall have successfully completed at the time of his appointment or within one year immediately following his appointment, the current approved home study course and the basic emergency management workshop. (N.J.S.A. App. A:9-40.1)
2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
3. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.
