Mayor and Council Regular Meeting - January 23, 2024

The Regular Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of North Caldwell was held on Tuesday, January 23, 2024. The meeting began at 6:31p.m. at Borough Hall and virtually via tele/video-conference.

Mayor Raymond called the meeting to order announcing that notice was provided in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 231, P.L. 1975. He provided a statement regarding the conduct of the teleconference which would allow members of the public to participate and be heard during public comment.

Roll Call indicated the following:

Mayor Raymond asked Matteo and Leon, North Caldwell Football Club players, to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### Mayor's Report

Mayor Raymond thanked event co-coordinator, Jenny Daly, and all who participated in the Martin Luther King, Jr. Day of Service event. He encouraged the public to propose ideas to bring the community together to help others.

## **Swearing In of Fire Chief Scott Stellfox**

Mayor Raymond administered the Oath of Office to Fire Chief Scott Stellfox who was accompanied by his daughter Brittany. The Mayor acknowledged Assistant Chief Larry Wefferling, former Chief John D'Ascensio and the volunteer firefighters who were present.

#### Citizens to be Heard - Any Subject Matter (5 minute limit)

On a motion by Council President Floria-Callori, seconded by Councilman Weinstein, public comment was opened.

Elliott Sommer, 143 Four Seasons Drive – Mr. Sommer requested a breakdown of water bills and confirmation that the consumption was estimated despite the installation of the remote meters. Mayor Raymond explained the inclusion of quarterly installments for the cost of the new meter in the bills. He stated that the remote readings would go live in February. Mayor Raymond offered to provide a more thorough explanation in a letter to residents which could be delivered to the Four Seasons Community. He offered to attend the HOA's meeting the following evening to explain the billing to residents.

Mr. Sommer requested an update on the Cell Tower Installation meeting with VComm and T-Mobile. Mayor Raymond announced the tentative date of March 6, 2024 which would be confirmed and then noticed to the public.

Hearing no further comments, Councilman Weinstein made a motion, seconded by Councilman Kessler, to close public comment. Said motion was carried unanimously.

## **Council Commentary**

Councilman Weinstein stated that 2024 Municipal Budget meetings were held with department heads. He noted that inflationary pressures and increasing cost of services will make it challenging to keep taxes flat.

Councilman Tilton expressed appreciation to former Fire Chief Tim Peterson for his service and wished Chief Stellfox luck in his new role.
