#### Common Symptoms of COVID-19

- ✓ Fever and chills
  ✓ Muscle and body aches
- ✓ New loss of taste or smell
- ✓ Nausea or vomiting
  ✓ Diarrhea

#### Common Symptoms of Both

- ✓ Cough
  - ✓ Itchy or watery eyes
    ✓ Sneezing

**Common Symptoms** 

of Allergies

- ✓ Sore throat
  ✓ Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing\*
- ✓ Congestion or runny nose

✓ Fatigue

✓ Headache

\*Seasonal allergies do not usually cause shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, unless a person has a respiratory condition such as asthma that can be triggered by exposure to pollen.
